**Funeral with a gun salute.** On Thursday, September 26<sup>th</sup> there was a funeral at the church for a 95 year old gentleman who served in several wars. At the end of his funeral there was a 3 gun salute for him outside of church. I was informed of this about 30 minutes before it happened. It was scheduled to happen between noon and 1:00pm so in order to prepare the students, I did get on the PA system to explain what was going to happen, why and what they should do during this time. I also asked the teachers to talk about it with the students especially in grades K, 1 and 2 because they would be outside for recess. I did ask the K-2 if they could show respect during the time of the salute by stopping their play, stand quietly and say a little prayer for this man. I was so proud of them because they did what was asked of them. Recess went quiet and the respect shown was wonderful.

I unfortunately forgot to inform you that this did occur during school hours in the event that your child(ren) didn't understand what was happening and came home afraid. I sincerely apologize for this lack of communication.

## **The Upper Providence Police**

A few years ago, the Upper Providence Police Department have made a point of stopping by the school at least once or twice a week to check on the school and our safety. They sign-in at the office and walk through the building and around the building checking on doors and making sure all is good. The students come to get familiar with their presence and welcome them in our school. I will be explaining their presence in the building to the students next week.
